Different families exist!

The narrow scope of the "ideal" family discourses, and the impact of heteronormative and patriarchal structure in its definition, have been brought into question, and many academics, activists, and scientists have begun to think about alternative definitions, forms, experiences, and relationships.

TEDU Center for Gender Studies and Ankara Gökkuşuğu Aileleri Derneği organized a webinar. Notable academics working at the intersection of family and gender, and activists from various LGBTI+ and feminist NGOs, were invited to participate in a two-day workshop titled as "'Different' Families Exist." The workshop included twelve presenters, seven individuals sharing their experiences, and six moderators. In different sessions, presenters addressed what the "ideal" family understanding is, how the family is understood and defined in terms of social policies and social services, how the family is defined in civil, labor, and criminal law in both Turkey and worldwide and the existence and possibilities of "other" family definitions and structures.
