The aim of the group is to raise awareness of global, cultural, and ecological issues such as sustainability, environmental policies, climate change, and inequalities within the pillars of education - research - governance - social contribution within a participatory system at TEDU, and to encourage action-oriented and socially beneficial steps to be taken on these issues. ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS	<ul> <li>Applications from groups of at least 3 people will be accepted. Teams may include;</li> <li>TEDU students (regardless of department and class)</li> <li>TEDU academics</li> <li>TEDU administrative staff</li> <li>Staff assigned by subcontractors (cleaning, catering, security services, etc.) to work at TEDU</li> <li>External stakeholders can also be included provided that TEDU members are in the majority</li> </ul>	
PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION DURATION	Max. 90 days (3 months)	
PROJECT VENUE	The implementation of the solution should be within the TED University Campus. The project venue can also include the campus surroundings, as long as they are campus-oriented proposals.	
RELATED SDGs	Solutions to be presented are expected to serve at least one SDG. There is no prioritization among the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).	
PROJECT CATEGORIES	<ul> <li>These categories are intended for inspiration only and are not restrictive:</li> <li>Participatory awareness raising activities and events</li> <li>Re-functionalization of a specific space</li> <li>Recommendations for product/service/process design for a Sustainable Campus</li> <li>Other activities that directly serve the purpose</li> </ul>	

APPLICATION LIMITATIONS EVALUATION	<ul> <li>The project idea must be original and must not have been awarded in any award/competition program before.</li> <li>A person can take part in maximum 3 groups/applications and can only be a group leader in one of these groups.</li> <li>Once the applications are closed, the jury members will make their</li> </ul>
PERIOD	evaluations in line with the criteria specified in this Application Guide and the projects that exceed the threshold score (80 points) will be selected. The winners will be announced at the Award Event.
EVALUATION CRITERIA	<ul> <li>Sustainable contribution to preventing the problem or addressing the need - 25 points</li> <li>Social/environmental impact (contribution to SDGs, negative impact, risk management) - 25 points</li> <li>Integrity, problem-solution fit, applicability - 25 points</li> <li>Team competence, collaboration, interdisciplinarity, inclusiveness, diversity - 10 points</li> <li>Originality - 10 points</li> <li>Multiplier effect, scalability - 5 points</li> </ul>
REWARDS	<ul> <li>The rewards for the three featured solutions include the following: <ul> <li>A certificate of achievement</li> <li>Representation at Sustainable TEDU</li> <li>Gift box containing sustainable products</li> <li>Visibility in the university's communication channels (such as web page, instagram account)</li> <li>A chance to share your ideas at RadioTEDU</li> <li>Mentoring to make your ideas come to life</li> <li>In-kind contributions that the University can provide - space/equipment</li> <li>Providing technical support for access to grant resources</li> <li>A field trip on a related topic</li> </ul> </li> <li>This Program will mainly reward ideas, but may also provide non-financial support (mentoring, visibility, space, equipment, etc.) to bring these ideas to life. In addition, some solutions will be selected for piloting and may also be financially supported.</li> </ul>
