- Disabled ramps,
- Sanitary pad distribution points,
- · Classrooms,
- Faculties,
- We aim to offer socialization areas.

The icons we have used in our map have been chosen according to the SDG color of the relevant application, and it is aimed to present which SDGs we focus on as TED University.

We are planning to present our map in plexiglass in order to be suitable for the purpose of sustainability. We aim to design the icons we will use in a magnetic way. In this way, when there is a change of location within the school, we will change the places of the icons and keep the map up-to-date, instead of tearing the papers of the map and reprinting it. We plan to keep our map in locked plexiglasses so that no changes are made outside of our knowledge.

Another goal is to add QR codes to our map. We plan to include the map information of other blocks in the relevant QR codes. In this way, if people are looking for the sanitary pad distribution point and there is no relevant application at the stage they are in, they will be able to view which stage they are in via the code they have read on their phone.

As a result, thanks to our TED University Sustainability Map, we are planning to quickly bring individuals to sustainable practices that have been and will be realized in all blocks of TED University.
